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Capacity Transfer without nomination attached (valid until 30th September 2024)

- A Domestic Shipper (DS) with capacity on the Swissgas (SWG) grid negotiates and agrees with a Transit Shipper (TS) holding capacity on the FluxSwiss (FLS) grid the transfer of a given capacity for the purpose of using it to supply the Swiss domestic market during emergency.
- TS emails FLS with DS and SWG in Cc by 15:00 of D-6 calendar days before the start date D of the transfer, notifying the validity period and the contact details of DS (company name, 24h phone number, email address).
- DS and SWG approve the TS request by replying to all by 16:00 D-6.
- By 17:00 D-6 calendar days, FLS confirms to TS, DS and SWG the implemented reduction of the TS capacity in FLS systems. To keep track of the transfer, FLS inserts the relevant capacity in a dummy contract in the name of DS. As DS will not be provided with any user accounts to operate on FLS systems, the transferred capacity cannot be nominated.
- For the agreed validity period of the capacity transfer, SWG is entitled to make available the transferred capacity to DS according to its own regular procedures, thus temporarily exceeding ist Lease Agreement quota.
- Upon receipt of a copy of the signed sublease agreement (ANNEX E: Secondary Marketing Form) between the FLS TS and the FLS and a transaction confirmation between the SWG TS and the FLS TS, SWG will proceed with the implementation of this agreement.

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Gas Transfer at the Virtual Intra-System Point (VISP) (valid until 30th September 2024)

- A Domestic Shipper (DS) with capacity on the Swissgas (SWG) grid negotiates and agrees with a Transit Shipper (TS) holding capacity on the FluxSwiss (FLS) grid the purchase of a given amount of gas with delivery at the Swiss Virtual Intra-System Point (VSP) for the purpose of supplying the Swiss domestic market during emergency.
- TS emails FLS with DS and SWG in Cc by 15:00 of D-1 for D or following gas days, notifying the validity period and the new requested pairing (e.g., EH* <> 12Y*).
- DS and SWG approve the TS request by replying to all by 16:00 D-1.
- By 17:00 D-1 FLS confirms to TS, DS and SWG the new implemented shipper codes pair in FLS systems as from D.
- Provided nominations by TS are balanced and submitted in due time, FLS will match them, and the nominated gas will be exchanged between TS and DS at the VISP.
